- Tax Research, etc.

Submissions must include the:

- project/case/simulation etc
- solution
- brief statement including the course where the project is used and the teaching objectives of the project.

Files should be submitted electronically in Microsoft Word or Adobe PDF format as email attachments to Brigitte Muehlmann [bmuehlmann@suffolk.edu]. Please indicate that the submission is to be considered for the conference by including “ATA Midyear Meeting submission” in the subject line of the email.

Authors will be expected to attend the ATA Mid-Year Meeting and develop a presentation of the case/project/etc, not to exceed five minutes. After the presentations, the authors will be available at tables to share their materials with interested ATA members.
