

2012 KPMG/ATA Tax Doctoral Consortium

The eighth annual KPMG/ATA Tax Doctoral Consortium will be held on Thursday, February 23, 2012 before the ATA midyear meeting in New Orleans.

The goal of the consortium is to help prospective new tax faculty make the right choices in the early stages of their careers so that they become successful scholars. While the program is designed to meet the needs of students with an interest in tax and that are in the middle stages of their doctoral program, applications from doctoral students at any level of their program, or who are undecided about taxation as a focus of their teaching and research, will be considered.

A low student-faculty ratio will provide an opportunity for doctoral students to meet and learn from successful tax faculty in both small group sessions and on an individual basis. The full program will be posted when it becomes available.
