2007 Mid-Year Conference

The 2007 Government and Non-Profit (GNP) Section Mid-Year Conference is co-hosted by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) and will take place March 2–3, 2007 at the GASB offices in Norwalk, Connecticut. The meeting is slated to offer interactive sessions with GASB staff, as well as panel discussions, paper presentations (academic, practitioner-related, pedagogical), and an opportunity to visit with others interested in GNP accounting.

Accommodations will be available at the Sheraton or Courtyard near the GASB offices. Hotel and registration information will be posted on the AAA and GNP section websites later this fall.

Submission procedures: You are invited to submit theoretical, practical/applied, and pedagogical papers or panel ideas on any GNP topic. As applicable, GASB staff will be reviewing conference submissions. Consistent with the 2006 mid-year meeting, abstracts describing emerging research issues will also be considered.

The submission deadline is January 5, 2007. Authors will be notified of paper acceptances by February 2, 2007. Papers should be presented at a maximum of two American Accounting Association meetings and should not have been published elsewhere.
