

Lela D. "Kitty" Pumphrey, PhD, CGFM, CPA, CMA, CIA, is currently a professor of accounting at Idaho State University in Pocatello, Idaho, USA. She served a 5-year term on the Idaho State Board of Accountancy (1999-2004), where she served as Chair 2003-2004. In that role she was charged with regulating the practice of accounting to protect the public interest. Currently she serves as a member of the NASBA's Examination Review Board.

Dr. Pumphrey has been actively involved in a variety of professional accounting organization including the Government and Not-for-Profit Section of the American Accounting Association, the Idaho Society of CPAs, the Arkansas Society of CPAs, the Association of Government Accountants, and the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy. She is also a member of the Institute of Internal Auditors and the Institute of Management Accountants. She served a 3-year term on the AICPA Governmental Accounting and Auditing Committee (1992-1995). Additionally, she served a 5-year term on the governing board of the Western American Accounting Association (1998-2003) where she served as 2001-2002 President.

Actively involved in practitioner-oriented research, Dr. Pumphrey has had papers presented at a number of academic conferences in the United States, Mexico, Thailand, and Australia. With several co-researchers in the areas of information systems and healthcare, she has been published in the United States, the United Kingdom, and Australia.

Dr. Pumphrey received her PhD from the University of Missouri, her MBA from Arkansas State University and BSBA from the University of Southern Mississippi. She worked in public accounting and as an internal auditor in the banking industry. She is a frequent presenter at professional conferences throughout the United States.
