2007 AAA-AI/ET Section Mid-Year Conference

January 3-6, 2007

Savannah, Georgia

The AI/ET Section of the AAA will hold its 2007 Mid-Year Conference, in conjunction with the Information Systems (IS) Section, in Savannah, Georgia, January 3-6, 2007. The meeting includes a plenary speaker, panel discussions, research and education paper sessions, and forum paper sessions. The "AIS New Scholar Consortium" sponsored by the IS section will precede the meeting. The Semantic Modeling of Accounting Phenomena (SMAP) workshop also precedes the conference on January 4.

We invite submissions related to all aspects of information systems and technology. We especially encourage submissions on (1) research in artificial intelligence and emerging technologies, (2) linkages of technology and systems with financial accounting, managerial accounting, taxation, international accounting, and public interest issues, (3) the technology revolution in accounting and its implications for the future of accounting practice, research, and education, and (4) accounting information systems education. Design science research is especially encouraged.

All documents should be submitted in Microsoft® Word format (.doc files). All tables, figures, and appendices must be placed in the same documents as the text of the paper. By November 21, 2006, authors of accepted conference papers must provide a final electronic copy of their manuscript.
