

# CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

## 2010 OHIO REGION MEETING of the AMERICAN ACCOUNTING ASSOCIATION

May 6 – 8, 2010  
Hyatt on Capital Square  
Columbus, Ohio

Accounting educators, students and professionals are invited to submit completed manuscripts and ideas for panels or workshops for presentation at the 51<sup>st</sup> Annual Meeting of the Ohio Region of the American Accounting Association. Papers may encompass any topical area of accounting and may be theoretical or practice-oriented. Accounting education papers and cases are strongly encouraged for submission. All papers submitted will be sent out for blind review.

The 2010 meeting will be held in Columbus, Ohio at the Hyatt on Capital Square. The hotel is located downtown and across from the capital at 75 East State Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. A limited number of hotel rooms have been set aside for conference participants at the rate of \$119 per night single occupancy and \$129 per night double occupancy. Free parking is available for those staying at the Hyatt. Academics and professionals from the Ohio region, as well as those from other regions and overseas, are welcome to participate. CPE credit will be available.

Student Manuscript Submissions and Competitions: Dr. David Bukovinsky of Wright State University (david.bukovinsky@wright.edu; or (937) 775-3643) will coordinate the two student manuscript awards that will be given at both the undergraduate and masters levels. Dr. Janet Greenlee of the University of Dayton (janet.greenlee@notes.udayton.edu; or (937) 229-4790) will coordinate the award for Best Doctoral Student Paper. Papers should be sent, no later than February 15, 2010, to the appropriate selection committee chair.

Papers by academics or professionals should be sent to Program Chair Dr. Jan Eighme of Miami University (eighmeje@muohio.edu; or (513) 529-6224). While one person may submit multiple papers, due to scheduling and space limitations, each person may present no more than two papers (but may be a co-author of a paper that another person presents). All those interested in reviewing manuscripts, being a discussant or being a moderator, please send an email to Jan.

Please send your proposals for panels and CPE sessions to Rob Larson at the University of Dayton (Robert.Larson@notes.udayton.edu).

The submission deadline is **January 31, 2010**. Early submissions are strongly encouraged. Notification of acceptance will be sent no later than March 15, 2010. At least one author of an accepted paper must register for the meeting and present the paper. Paper and panel presentations will take place all day Friday, and until about noon on Saturday.
