

Announcement and Call for Papers

Conference on

Regulation and the Audit Industry

May 18-19, 2012

The Steed School of Accounting at the University of Oklahoma will hold a conference on Regulation and the Audit Industry May 18-19, 2012. Six papers will be presented workshop style. Topics for submitted papers should relate to the role/effects of regulation on the audit industry and/or on the interface between auditing and financial reporting. Papers relating to new or emerging regulations are particularly encouraged. Possible topics include audit risk issues, management judgment and estimates, audit quality, industry dynamics/competition, IFRS, and proposed PCAOB changes in the auditor reporting model--such as auditing information outside the primary financial statements and changes to the audit report.

Submitted papers should be in TAR or JAR format and should not have been accepted for publication at the time of submission. Submissions should be made electronically to fayres@ou.edu. There is no submission fee and no formal reviews will be provided. Accepted papers will be selected by the Steed School of Accounting Conference Committee. All research methods (archival, theoretical or experimental) will be considered. The submission deadline is March 1 and decisions will be announced by April 8. Travel expenses will be provided for presenters.
