CALL FOR PAPERS

The main theme of 2009 Accounting Theory and Practice Conference is “The Era of IFRS: Challenges for Accounting Educators”. More than 100 countries have recently converged/switched to International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) reporting or have decided to adopt these standards in the near future. The Financial Supervisory Commission of Taiwan also announced that all listed companies will be required to follow IFRSs starting from 1 January 2013. This convergence presents enormous challenges for accounting educators. For example, one challenge is to develop programs that teach IFRS and prepare students with professional judgment skills necessary to succeed in implementing principles-based accounting standards. In this two days conference we will explore many aspects of this evolving issue to inform accounting educators of changes they need to embrace. We welcome academics and practitioners from around the globe to attend our conference. Papers are invited in all areas of accounting for the conference to be held at National Cheng Kung University in Tainan City.

Information on submitting papers

1. There is no submission fee. The full paper should be typed on letter size paper, double-spaced using Microsoft Word. Three hard copies and an electronic copy of the full paper are required for the reviewing process. Please save your all contents and abstract in DOC or PDF format, and upload them to “Paper Uploading” area of “2009 Accounting Theory and Practice Conference” website (URL: <http://www.acc.ncku.edu.tw/2009TAA>). Uploading will be available beginning on July 20, 2009.
2. A cover page is required with the following information: name(s) of author(s), affiliation(s), address(es), telephone number(s), fax number(s), and e-mail address(es). The submitted paper should also include an abstract with no more than five hundred words and three key words.
3. The format of the full paper must follow the requirements of The Accounting Review.
4. Two anonymous experts will blind review each submitted paper. All accepted papers are presented at the conference and appear in the conference proceedings. Abstracts and full articles will be published in a conference proceedings volume to be made available on CD and later archived on the Web.
