37TH ANNUAL MEETING
Hyatt Regency Hotel, Morristown, NJ
September 30 to October 2, 2010



The 37th Annual Meeting of the Northeast Business and Economics Association will be held at the Hyatt Regency Hotel, Morristown, on September 30 to October 2, 2010. Montclair State University has the privilege to be the host institution for this event. This conference will include papers and sessions that span a wide range of current research topics in economics, finance, and business. We invite academic researchers and professional practitioners to submit research papers, and/or research proposals relating to all aspects of business and economics for consideration in the program. We also welcome proposals for tutorials and panel discussions, especially from practitioners.

Submission Procedure

Authors may submit their work electronically via this email address: 2010NBEA@mail.montclair.edu. There is no submission fee.

All papers and proposals will be refereed in a blind peer review process by at least two members of the executive board or program committee. All submissions must include two title pages. The first should include the title, primary track designation, and contact information of each author (name, affiliation, email address, and phone number). The second should include only the title, abstract, primary track designation and keywords.

Research papers should be in PDF format and not exceed 25 pages in length.

Research proposals and Panel proposals should be in PDF format and not exceed 5 pages in length.

The deadline for paper/proposal submission is April 1, 2010. If your paper/proposal is accepted for presentation at the conference, you are expected to submit the completed paper by July 15, 2010.

Authors will be notified of acceptance decisions by June 1, 2010. Authors of all accepted papers will have the option of publishing their papers or abstracts in the *2010 Proceedings of the Northeast Business and Economics Association*. A template for the proceedings with publication requirements and guidelines will be sent to the corresponding author upon notification of acceptance.

Awards

The NBEA will choose the winner of \$250 for the Best Paper Award. There will also be one or two awards of \$250 for Best Paper by Junior Faculty and one or two \$250 awards Best Papers by Doctoral Students. The NBEA will waive the registration fee for all award recipients.

Authors of all completed papers are eligible to compete for the Best Paper Award. Only doctoral students (who are enrolled full or part-time in a program that leads to a doctoral degree in any business related area) and junior faculty (who are employed in a full-time tenure track position, does not yet have tenure, and has earned his or her doctoral degree within the past 10 years) are eligible for the Junior Faculty/Doctoral Student Best Paper Award. Completed papers must be received by July 15, 2010 for award consideration. The award recipients are also eligible to submit their papers to the *Journal of Business and Economic Studies* for fast-track reviews.

Registration

The conference registration fee is \$230. However, registrations on or before August 1, 2010 are eligible for the discounted early registration fee of \$190.
