TRANSPORTATION

Airport Transportation via MAX to Embassy Suites Downtown Portland

1. From Airport, board MAX red line to City Center and Beaverton TC. Fare is \$1.95. Travel time 35 minutes.
2. Get off at Oak/SW 1st Ave. MAX station
3. Walk .2 mi NW to 319 Pine St. to Embassy Suites

Fareless Square

Ride for free in downtown Portland

1. All trips that begin and end within Fareless Square are **free**—all day, every day.
2. Fareless Square includes most of downtown Portland (within the boundaries of the Willamette River, NW Irving Street, and the I-405 freeway), as well as MAX stations from the Rose Quarter to **Lloyd Center** and bus stops along NE Multnomah to 13th Avenue.
3. When boarding a bus, MAX or streetcar in Fareless Square, just take a seat and enjoy the ride—on us! Fare is not required unless you are traveling outside of the Square

How to Ride MAX Light Rail

1. Max goes to Downtown (Pioneer Square & Pearl District), and Washington Park.
2. If you are starting and stopping within Fareless Square no ticket is needed. Trains run every 5-15 minutes every day roughly between 4:30 a.m. and midnight.
3. Outside of Fareless square you must have a validated ticket, bus transfer receipt or monthly pass *before* boarding MAX. Ticket machines are located at each station.
4. Signs at the station indicate where to wait and when the next train is due. Signs on the front of each train identify the line (Blue, Red or Yellow) and destination.
5. MAX stops at every station. The station name is announced before each stop and appears on a reader board overhead. **Pioneer Square Station is the Preferred exit to get off in downtown.**

How to Ride the Portland Streetcar

1. The Portland Streetcar runs on a three-mile loop connecting NW 23rd Avenue, Portland City Center, Portland State University, and RiverPlace. Stations are located every 2-3 blocks and trains run until about 11:30 p.m. (10:30 on Sundays).
2. You can buy a ticket on board or validate your previously purchased ticket on board the Streetcar.
3. Reader boards at each station show when the next train is due. Signs on the front of each train display the Streetcar's destination.
4. The Streetcar does not stop at every station automatically. When you want to get off, push the yellow strip on the wall or the button by the door. The station name is announced before each stop and appears on a reader board overhead.
