Accounting Position Fall 2006

Assistant Professor of Accounting, Department of Accounting, Murray State University. Full time, tenure track position to begin August 2006. Position will be nationally advertised during the summer, 2005.

Qualifications: Doctoral degree in accounting from an AACSB-accredited university with a residence requirement. Degree completion expected by start of contract period. Professional certification and recent professional experience desirable. Demonstrated effectiveness in classroom teaching, ability to produce quality research, and a commitment to service are required. Candidates with ability and competency in teaching auditing are especially encouraged to apply, although other fields of expertise will be considered.

Responsibilities: Teach accounting courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Engage in research resulting in publications in recognized refereed journals. Provide university and regional service.

About Murray State University: Located in the Jackson Purchase lake area of west Kentucky, Murray State is a state-assisted comprehensive university with five academic colleges. The university's 236-acre main campus is in Murray, a city of 16,000. Murray State has been continuously accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) since 1928. Program accreditations have also been attained in business (AACSB-International), art, animal health technology, counseling, dietetics, several engineering technology programs, chemistry, journalism and mass communications, music, nursing, occupational safety and health, physics and engineering physics, social work, special education, teacher education and veterinary laboratory diagnostics.

About the Department of Accounting: The Department of Accounting has nine faculty members and offers both undergraduate and graduate degrees in accounting, including a 150 hour dual-degree program. The program graduates 30 to 40 students each year and is recognized regionally for its quality. Students typically accept positions in public accounting, industry, or government, and many of the department's graduates hold executive level offices within their organizations.
