

Source Normalized Impact per Paper (SNIP)

SNIP is a measure of article impact. SNIP measures citation impact by “normalizing” citation values for the radically different patterns of citation between disciplines. SNIP also counters the various manipulations of citation rankings and considers immediacy (how quickly a paper is likely to have an impact in a given field).
