The 2025 Haskayne and Fox Accounting Conference
Accounting Horizons

The 2025 Haskayne and Fox Accounting Conference (HFAC) will be held in collaboration with *Accounting Horizons* on July 7-9, 2025, at Whistler Village, British Columbia, Canada. The conference will include (1) a plenary session featuring presentations and discussions of three research papers submitted to *Accounting Horizons* on this Call and selected by the editorial team, (2) concurrent sessions for research presentations and discussions by attendees on an invitation basis, and (3) a keynote speech and/or panel discussions.

The 2025 HFAC will be the fifth conference in this immensely successful series that includes conferences at Lake Louise (2019, 2023, 2024) and Whistler (2022). The HFAC is one of the most coveted accounting conferences in North America, with stimulating professional development and networking through small group interactions both indoors and outdoors.

Accounting Horizons is one of the three association-wide journals published by the American Accounting Association (AAA) and the second-most-downloaded journal in the AAA family of 17 journals. As an academic journal, *Accounting Horizons* aims to bridge accounting academics and non-academics by publishing rigorous original research papers and thought-provoking perspectives articles. This Call is for original research papers to be presented at the plenary session of the conference.

An original research paper should address a single timely research question that is important to accounting practice and be written in clear, concise, and plain language that is comprehensible to a broad audience. Authors are encouraged to use figures to accompany a minimum number of necessary tables. Research methods may be analytical, archival, experimental, or qualitative. We welcome descriptive studies of new phenomena or emerging issues; first evidence after new regulations; or hypothesis testing on a single but fundamental research question. The submission should include up to 25 pages of text (double-spaced, 12-point font, and normal margins) and 40 pages in total.

Please submit your manuscripts through the *Accounting Horizon's* homepage (<https://aaahq.org/Research/Journals/Accounting-Horizons>) by **January 15, 2025** and **indicate in your cover letter that your submission is for this Call**. The *Accounting Horizons* editorial team will decide by March 1, 2025, which papers will be selected for the plenary session presentation. Coauthors of the selected papers will be invited to attend the HFAC at their own cost. After presentation, the papers will be further processed at *Accounting Horizons* using the normal review standards.
