

# Call for Nominations Accounting Horizons Memorials

In keeping with the American Accounting Association's <u>Policy of Memorials in Accounting Horizons</u>, the <u>Accounting Horizons</u> <u>Memorials Committee</u> invites nominations for memorials to appear in <u>Accounting Horizons</u>. Memorials honor individuals whose work significantly advanced accounting thought or revolutionized practice

and professional development.

### **Eligibility**

Nominees must have made significant contributions to accounting thought or practice and must have been deceased for at least 365 days prior to nomination.

## **Nomination Package:**

- 1. Nomination letter: one to two pages, single-spaced, with the name and title of the nominee before his/her retirement and the name and contact information of the nominator(s). The letter should include a brief biographical sketch of the nominee and an outline of their significant contributions.
- 2. Letters of support: please include three to five letters of support.
- 3. Supporting material: the nominator(s) is encouraged to include significant supporting primary source material up to five items. If a specific item is available online, please add the link to the website instead of attaching the actual document.
- 4. Vita/Resume: please include the latest vita or resume (if available) for the nominee.

#### **Submission Guidelines:**

- 1. Combine all documents into a single PDF.
- 2. Submit by November 30, 2025.
- 3. Decisions will be announced by March 2026.
- 4. Nominations should be submitted to: <a href="memorials@aaahq.org">memorials@aaahq.org</a>.

#### **Review Process**

- 1. Nominations will be reviewed by external referees under a single-blind process.
- 2. The committee will make final decisions by majority rule.
- 3. Selected memorials will be assigned to a primary author (not necessarily a nominator).
- 4. The completed memorial manuscript will be submitted to *Accounting Horizons* and undergo a review process.
