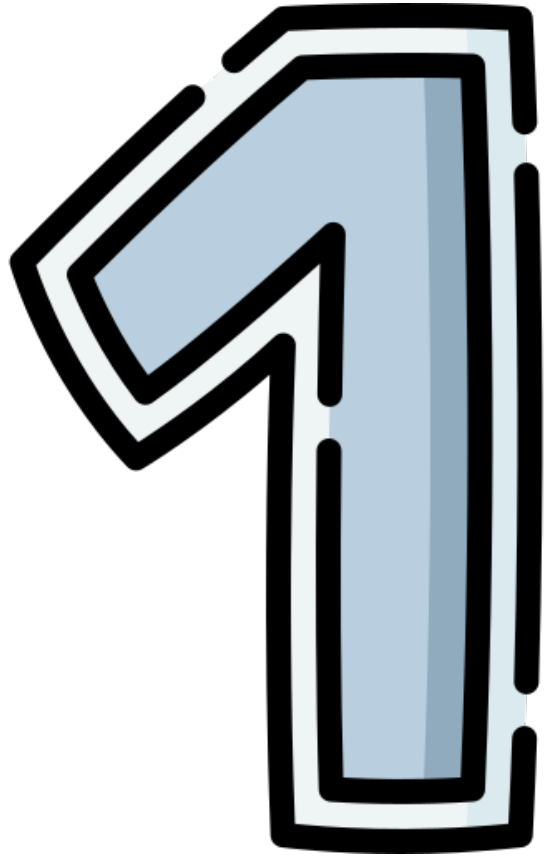

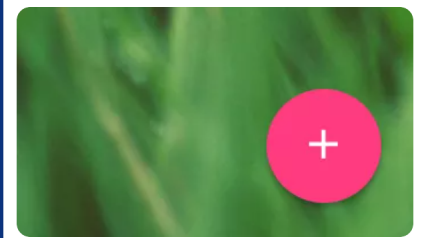

How to make a post

How do I post?



See that big pink button in the bottom right corner? It adds a new post. You can also double click anywhere on a padlet, or copy/paste items directly onto a padlet.

You can also drag a file directly from your desktop onto the padlet.

Posts appear instantly and simultaneously, even when multiple people are working on the same padlet at once.

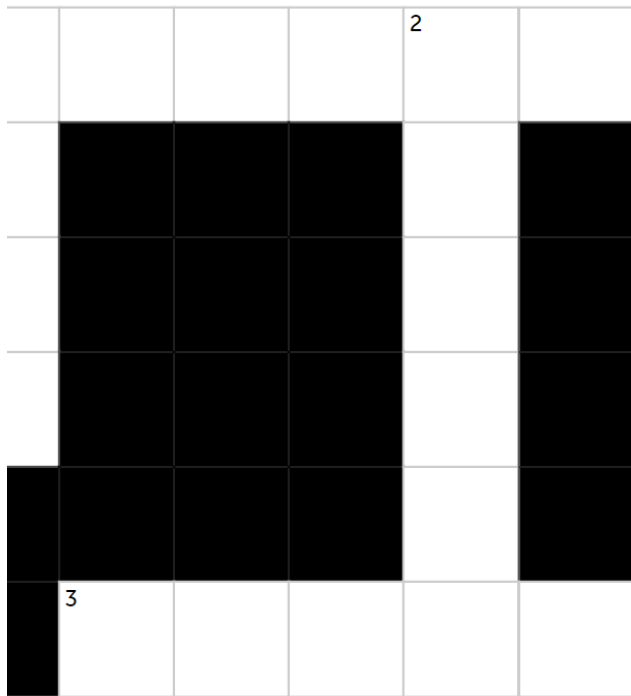

Question 23: Rohrer Co. has the following data for June:

- Beginning inventory, 10 units @ \$12 each = \$120
- Purchases in June, 5 units @ \$15 each = \$75
- Ending inventory is 7 units
- 8 units were sold during June

What is the cost of goods sold using the Last-in, First-out (LIFO) method?

LIFO
Sold units = Newest
End inv = oldest

Ending inventory 7 units @ \$12 = \$84

COGS → 8 units:

- Purchases → 5 units @ \$15 = \$75
- Beg inv → 3 units @ \$12 = 36

COGS → \$111

Cost of goods avail

\$195	
- 84	End inv

Create mail merge emails

What is mail merge?


- Feature in Word that allows users to create a batch of personalized documents or emails by connecting a Word document to a data source, such as an Excel file
- Use it to save time and personalize communications
- Examples: Personalized emails, certificates, etc.

Why use mail merge?

- Saves time
- Personalizes communications
- Consistency

- Examples: Personalized emails, certificates, letters

Step 1: Prepare Excel file

- Excel file needs to contain:
 - Student first name
 - Student email
 - Some designation for which email to send (i.e., good job, tutoring available, come see me, etc.”)

Step 2: Create mail merge doc in Word

1. Open MS Word and start a new document
2. Go to Mailings tab and select “Start Mail Merge” > “E-mail Messages”
3. Click “Select Recipients” > “Use an Existing List” and choose your Excel file
4. Insert merge fields from Excel columns
5. Choose “Edit Recipient List” as needed

Step 3: Sending emails

1. Write the email template in Word using fields from Excel
2. Preview results to ensure fields merge correctly
3. Click “Finish & Merge” > “Send E-Mail Messages”
4. Repeat for other emails as needed

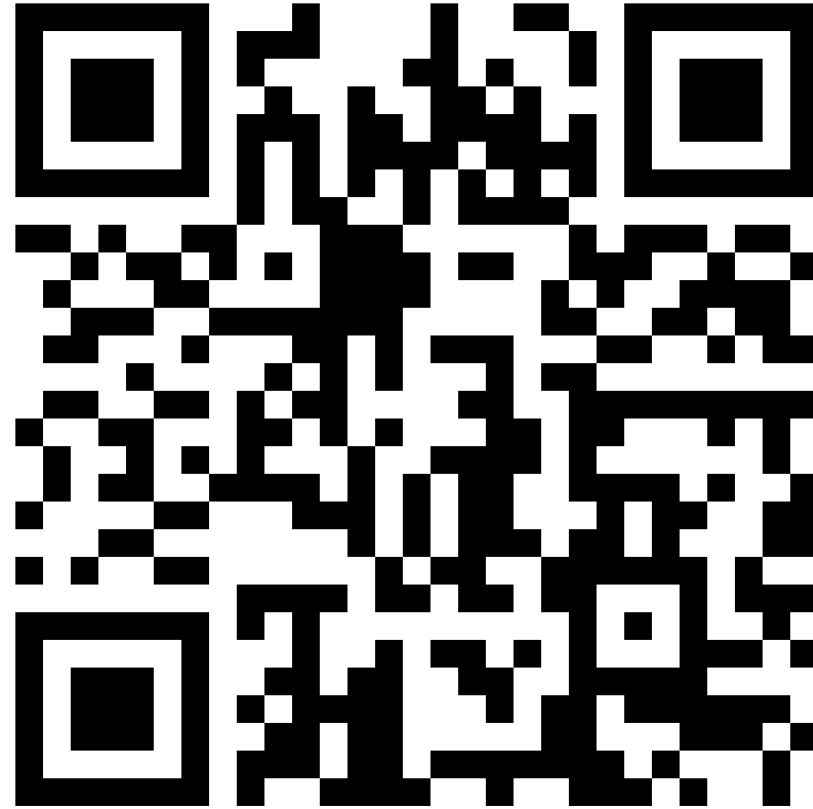
