Merchandise Stocks.

To obtain merchandise for Stock, the men in charge of the Stock in the several Departments must make a Requisition (Form No. 69) in carbon duplicate, giving number of pieces, or pounds, sizes or kinds, of articles wanted, and forward same to the Purchasing Department.

STOCK REQUISITION.

Attached to Requisition (Form No. 69) is a stub, which is to be sent with the Requisition

to the Purchasing Department.

The Purchasing Department will then make out an Order "T" Form (No. 15) in carbon duplicate, on the various shippers or manufacturers, and show on the same for what Department ordered.

The Purchasing Department will then note the number of their Order on Stub of the Requisition, and return the Stub to the Department making same, for their information, and file with the Requisition copy, so that the Department ordering may have full knowledge as to how to apply the goods when received.

Notice of shipment of goods so ordered is received in advance, by the shippers sending copy of Bill of Lading, which is referred on

receipt to the Receiving Department.

These Bills of Lading are then given to a "Runner" or Freight Messenger, who attends to all payments for freight and charges, and instructs Truck Drivers to pick up and deliver to Store.

The same method is followed in obtaining Blank Books, Stationery, and miscellaneous supplies, the Requisitions being made on the Supply Department, instead of the Purchasing Department.

All other features of the work being followed the same as those outlined for Merchandise Stocks, except that the Invoices are passed to credit of Shippers, and charged to various Expense Accounts, through the "Expense Invoice Book".

Story of a Sales Order.

ORDER RECORDING.

In the distribution of the Mail, the Sales Orders are divided into three (3) classes, viz;

City, Country, and Plumbing Department.

The City Orders are sent direct to the City Order Department.

Here, each Order is given an "individuality," by being given a Blue Record Number, and opposite the corresponding number on an Order Record Sheet, is noted the name of the Customer, Number of Order, (if any) and name of Packer or Porter, to whom same has been assigned for filling.

Ongoing Digitization Projects:

- Correspondence of the AAPA (1887-1917) and the AIA (1917-1957)
 - Finished the AAPA years and now on the AIA years.
 - A little under 500 letters, with accompanying forms, reports, brochures, and other enclosures, have already been uploaded. There are around 600 more to do.
- Tax Adviser
 - Begun digitizing the first 17 years, 1970-1986, which are not in the major commercial *Accounting and Tax* database.
 - The articles posted in the last two months have already garnered 3,500 downloads.
- Journal of Accountancy
 - Completed the first tranche of issues 1905-1940.
 - Now on to 1941.

New Digitization Project:

- Management of an Accounting Practice (MAP) Handbook
 - The five-volume set began in 1975 and ended in 2017. It was a very popular publication among practitioners, offering up-to-date advice on issues ranging from buying, selling, or merging an accounting practice to office filing procedures.
