Special Issue of the *Journal of Information Systems*

Data Protection, Privacy and Privacy Risk Management

The Journal of Information Systems (JIS) is the journal of the Information Systems Section of the American Accounting Association (www.jisonline.com). JIS will publish a special section in the Fall 2013 issue entitled “Data Protection, Privacy and Privacy Risk Management.” Enterprise systems generally contain much personal information both captured and used by accounting information systems, as well as personal information collected for other business purposes and reasons, sometimes even collected “accidentally.” Data breaches are reported literally every day, and litigation has become common. Globally, Data Protection Agencies are increasingly holding organizations responsible and levying fines and sanctions.

The Special Issue will combine academic research papers with contributions from leaders in the professional community. Examples of topics for the Special Issue include:

- Privacy risk management strategies related to controls over data and business processes
- Data minimization and data pollution reduction
- Strategies and benefits of using GAPP (Generally Accepted Privacy Principles) and the AICPA/CICA’s related Privacy Maturity Model
- Studies of consequences to and/or risk management strategies of organizations with data breaches
- Case studies of Privacy by Design and/or Privacy by Redesign
- Behavioral aspects and risk reduction of employee privacy awareness training programs
- Auditing data protection policies and SOC 2 and SOC 3 reports for 3rd party outsourcing
- Cross-cultural and geographical studies of data breaches and company policies and procedures
- Cloud computing and data protection

All research methods are welcome, including review, analytical, archival, design science, behavioral, qualitative, field and case study.
