## Alan Webb, University of Waterloo (Retired) Recipient, 2024 AAA Management Accounting Section Lifetime Contribution to Management Accounting Award



Alan Webb received his PhD from the *University of Alberta* in 2001 and has spent most of his career at the *University of Waterloo* where he now is Emeritus Professor. Throughout his career, Dr. Webb is not only remarkably productive when it comes to his own research, he has also made substantial contributions to the academic community through his teaching, impact on practice, and service to the community. His influence has left a lasting mark on the profession in various ways.
