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Charges

- 1 Review the final report of the prior year committee and follow up with the prior year-committee chair for insight as to the committee's operations as well their prior and ongoing initiatives and concerns.
- 2 Identify new tax faculty and doctoral students. Invite them to join the ATA and participate in the Midyear Meeting. Encourage them to submit papers to the New Faculty and Doctoral Students Paper Session at the Midyear Meeting. Encourage new faculty to apply for the ATA/PricewaterhouseCoopers Doctoral Dissertation Award.
- 3 Welcome and introduce new faculty and doctoral students at the Midyear Meeting.
- 4 Organize a New Faculty breakfast at the Midyear Meeting. Consider inviting experienced faculty from various types of schools (e.g., research, teaching) to attend and possibly speak at the breakfast.
